Scholarship:

Applicant must:

- be a resident of Canada
- be a hobby genealogist (i.e. not having an advertised genealogical business entity)
- submit a write up outlining:
 - research experience to date
 - genealogical memberships
 - volunteer work related to genealogy
 - employment activities related to genealogy
 - the genealogical-based course, seminar or conference to be taken/attended and an overview of content, (this can be online or other)
 - how attendance or course completion will expand current knowledge in field of research, or as a genealogist
 - how the information gained from this experience will be shared
 - monetary amount requested
